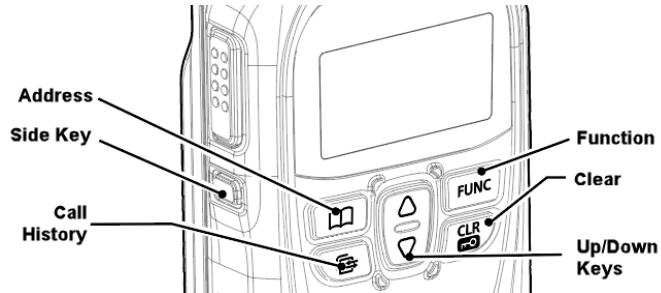


IP501H: Using the Record Function

Note: The record function records only *received calls*, not transmitted calls.



Enabling Recording

Recording is enabled in the Advanced Set Mode. To enter:

1. Hold down the FUNC and Address keys and turn on the power. Continue to hold down the FUNC and Address keys until **SET** appears in the upper left of the Display.
2. Press the Address key (book icon) repeatedly until **RECORDING** appears under **SET** on the Display.
3. Press the Down key to select **Enable**.
4. Press the FUNC key to select **Record Call type**.
5. Press the Up/Down keys to select **All** or **Individual Call (Call Type)**.
 - **All**: Both Talkgroup (TG) and Individual calls received on the radios are recorded.
 - **Individual Call**: Only Individual calls received on the radios are recorded.
6. Press the CLR key, and after a few seconds the radio will return to normal mode.
7. When the radio has returned to the normal operating Display, Press FUNC twice so that **Recording/OFF** appears on the Display.
8. Press the Down key to select **ON** and then press CLR. A tape recorder icon will appear on the Display showing that the recording function is now enabled.

Accessing Recordings

If you have recorded receive audio, the tape recorder icon on the Display will be flashing. If you have set the **Record Call Type** (as shown in step 5 above) to **All**, you will be able to record both individual and Talkgroup calls.

1. Press the Call History key repeatedly until you select **Recording Log** on the Display.
2. Press the Side key (under the PTT) to playback the recording. After playback, the radio will return to the opening Display and the tape recorder icon will no longer flash, though the Rx audio will stay in the memory.

Deleting Recordings

To delete all recordings, you must be in Advanced Set Mode (as in Enabling Recording).

1. Press FUNC repeatedly until **Delete Recording** Appears.
2. Select **CLR** with the down key.
3. Press the Call History key to delete all recordings.
